PAPER PRESENTATION

PAPER INFORMATION

Themes of the papers should be compatible with the thematic fields of the meeting. The size of the papers should be from four to six pages. The papers will be reviewed by the reviewers appointed by the Scientific Committee.

Paper Application Pre-Submission should include the title of the paper, name and title of the author, short abstract (not longer than 150 words) and key words (5 words maximum).

- ☞ If the paper is positively reviewed
- ☞ If the registration fee is paid.
